

Highway 45 & Highway G - Eagle River, Wisconsin FEMA - Flood Insurance Rate Map

NOTES TO USERS

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size. The opportunity may nevertheless be consulted for possible updated or additional flood hazard information.

Special Flood Hazard Areas were determined by approximate study methods.

The projections used in the preparation of this map were Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) zone 16. The horizontal datum was NAD 83. GRS 1980 spheroid. Computations in block, spherical, projection or UTM zones used in the production of FIRMs for adjacent jurisdictions may result in slight positional differences in this National Flood Insurance Rate Map. These differences do not affect the accuracy of this FIRM.

Flood elevations on this map are referenced to the North American Vertical Datum of 1988. These flood elevations must be compared to structure and ground elevations referenced to the same vertical datum. 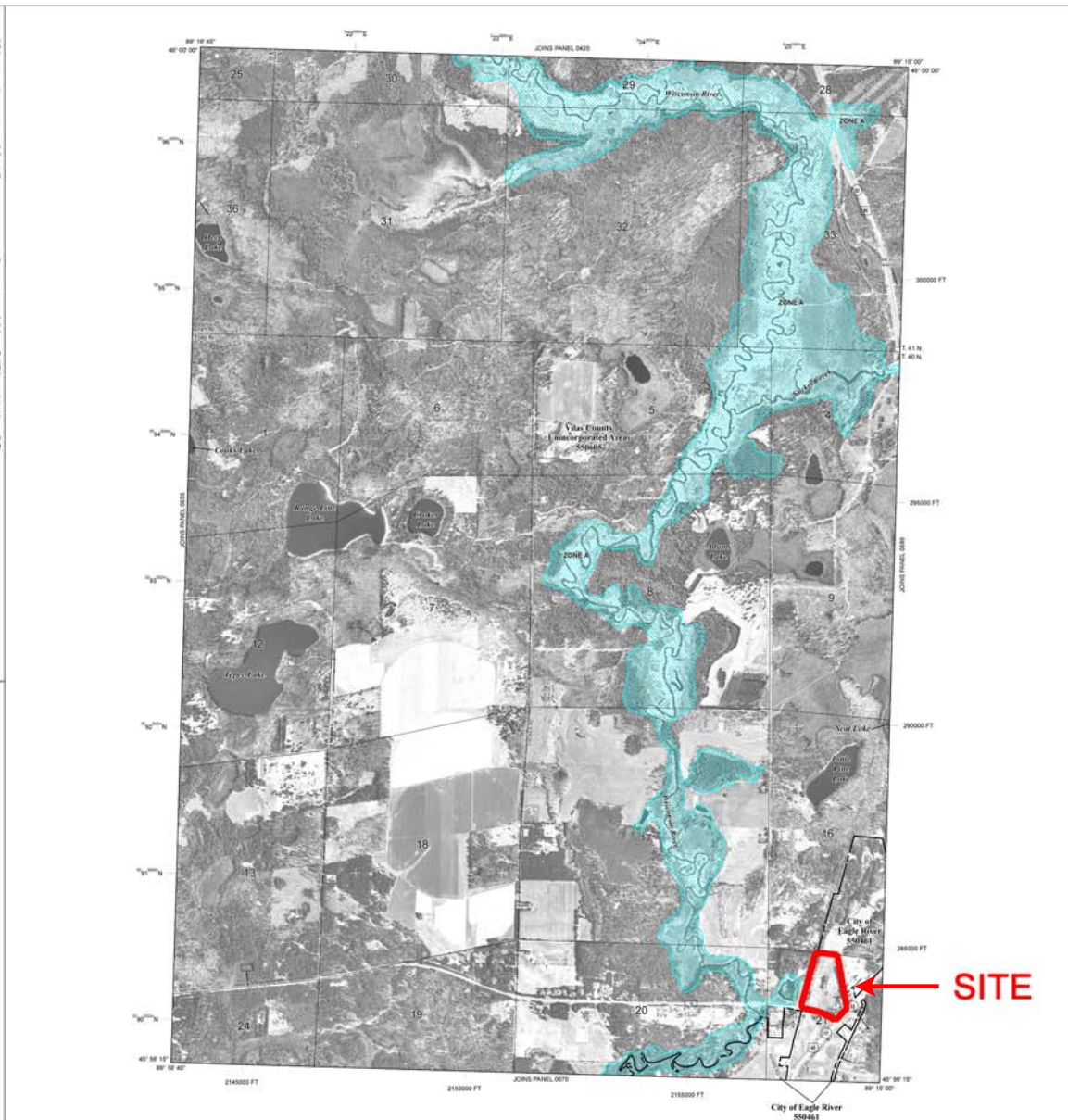

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS (SFHA) SUBJECT TO INUNDATION BY THE 1% ANNUAL CHANCE FLOOD
The 1% annual chance flood (100-year flood) also known as the base flood, is the flood that has a 1% chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year. The Special Flood Hazard Area is the area subject to flooding by the 1% annual chance flood. Areas of Special Flood Hazard include Zone A, A-1, A-2, A-3, A-99, and V. The Base Flood Elevation is the elevation of the flood.

ZONE A
No Base Flood Elevation determined.

ZONE A-1

ZONE A-2
Base Flood Elevation determined.

ZONE A-3
Base Flood Elevation determined.

ZONE A-99
Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHA) subject to the 1% annual chance flood. Areas of Special Flood Hazard subject to the 1% annual chance flood are subdivided into zones. Zone A-99 indicates that the former flood control system is being retained to provide protection from the 1% annual chance or greater flood.

ZONE V
Coastal Flood zone with velocity hazard (wave action); no Base Flood Elevation determined.

ZONE VE
Coastal Flood zone with velocity hazard (wave action); Base Flood Elevation determined.

FLOODWAY AREAS IN ZONE A-1
The floodway is the channel of a stream plus any adjacent floodplain areas that must be kept free of obstructions so that the 1% annual chance flood can be carried without substantial increases in flood heights.

OTHER FLOOD AREAS

ZONE B
Areas of 0.2% annual chance flood; areas of 1% annual chance flood with annual depth of one foot or less with average area less than 1 square mile, and areas protected by levees from 1% annual chance flood.

ZONE D
Areas determined to be outside the 0.2% annual chance floodway.
